

## Dog Dishcloth

### Materials:

Wendy Craft Cotton x 1 ball  
4.50mm needles  
4.50mm Crochet hook

### Abbreviations:

k = knit  
p = purl  
sts = stitches

### Cast on 37sts.

**Row 1:** (k1, p1) across row.

**Row 2:** (k1, p1) across row.

**Row 3 :** (k1, p1) across row.

**Row 4:** (k1, p1) across row.



***1 ball of Wendy Craft Cotton makes all three dish cloths including the soap bag***

### Pattern:

**Row 5:** (k1, p1); k9; p5; k5; p5; k9; (p1, k1).

**Row 6:** (k1, p1); k1; p7 k1; p5; k1; p3; k1; p5; k1; p7; k1; (p1, k1).

**Row 7:** (k1, p1); k8; p1; k5; p1; k3; p1; k5; p1; k8; (p1, k1).

**Row 8:** (k1, p1); k1; p6; k1; p6; k1; p2; k1; p6; k1; p7; k1; (p1, k1).

**Row 9:** (k1, p1); k9; p2; k4; p1; k3; p2; k4; p1; k7; (p1, k1).

**Row 10:** (k1, p1); k1; p6; k1; p3; k1; p5; k1; p3; k1; p10; k1; (p1, k1).

**Row 11:** (k1, p1); k11; p1; k3; p1; k5; p1; k3; p1; k7; (p1, k1).

**Row 12:** (k1, p1); k1; p6; k1; p3; k1; p5; k1; p3; k1; p10; k1; (p1, k1).

**Row 13:** (k1, p1); k11; p1, k3, p1; k5; p1; k3; p1; k7 (p1, k1).

**Row 14:** (k1, p1); k1; p6; k1; p3; k1; p2; k3; p4; k1; p10; k1; (p1, k1).

**Row 15:** (k1, p1); k11; p1; k7; p2; k4; p1; k7; (p1, k1).

**Row 27:** (k1, p1); k4; p1; k12; p6; (k2, p1) x2; k4; (p1; k1).

**Row 28:** (k1, p1); k1; p3; k1; p2; k1; p8; k1; p1; k2; p8; k1; p3; k1 (p1, k1).

**Row 29:** (k1, p1); k4; p1; k12; p1; k7; p1, k2; p1; k4; (p1, k1).

**Row 30:** (k1, p1); k1; p3; k1; p2; k1; p7; k1; p1; k4; p7; k1; p3; k1 (p1, k1).

**Row 31:** (k1, p1); k4; p1; k12; p1; k7; p1; k2; p1; k4 (p1, k1).  
**Row 32:** (k1, p1); k1; p3; k1; p2; k1; p7; k1; p1; k4; p7; k1; p3; k1 (p1, k1).  
**Row 33:** (k1, p1); k4; p4; k2; p1; k6; p1; k7; p1, k2; p1; k4; (p1, k1).  
**Row 34:** (k1, p1): k1; p3; k1; p2; k1; p7; k1; p1; k4; p3; k1; p7; k1; (p1, k1).  
**Row 35:** (k1, p1); k8; p1; k8; p1; k7; p1, k2; p1; k4; (p1, k1).  
**Row 36:** (k1, p1); k1; p3; k1; p3; k1; p6; k1; p1; k4; p3; k1; p7; k1; (p1, k1).  
**Row 37:** (k1, p1); k8; p1; k8; p1; k6; p1; k3; p1; k4; (p1, k1).  
**Row 38:** (k1, p1); k1; p4; k1; p3; k1; p5; k1; p2; k2; p4; k1; p7; k1; (p1, k1).  
**Row 39:** (k1, p1); k9; (p1, k6) x2; p1; k2; p1; k6; (p1, k1).  
**Row 40:** (k1, p1); k1; p6; k3; p7; k6; p9; k1; (p1, k1).  
**Row 41:** (k1, p1); k33; (p1, k1).  
**Row 42:** (k1, p1) across row  
**Row 43:** (k1, p1) across row  
**Row 44:** (k1, p1) across row  
**Row 45:** (k1, p1) across row

**Cast off.**

## Diagonal Garter Stitch

**Cast on 4sts.**

**Row 1:** Knit 4

**Row 2:** Knit 2, yarn over, knit to end of row  
 Repeat row 2 until you have 44 stitches.

Knit 1, Knit 2 together, yarn over, knit 2 together, knit to the end of row. Repeat the above row until you have 4 stitches left.

**Cast off.**

**Sew in ends.**

## Textured dishcloth

**Cast on 33sts.**

Knit 4 rows garter stitch

**Row 1:** K4, P1,\* K1, P1,  
 repeat from \* to last 4 stitches, K4

**Row 2:** K4, K1, \*P1, K1,  
 repeat from \* to last 4 stitches, K4

**Row 3:** Knit across whole row

**Row 4:** Knit across whole row

Repeat rows 1 – 4 10 times,  
 then repeat rows 1 and 2 once.

Knit in garter stitch for 4 rows

**Cast off.**

**Sew in ends.**

## Soap Bag

**Cast on 30sts.**

**Rows 1 – 4:** Knit across row

**Row 5:** Knit across row.

**Row 6:** Purl across row

Repeat rows 5 and 6, 3 more times.

**Row 13 - 16:** Knit across row (Garter stitch)

**Row 17 – 24:** – repeat rows 5 and 6

**Row 25:** K1, \*YO, K2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

**Rows 26 and 27:** Knit across row

**Row 28:** Purl across row.

**Row 29:** Knit across row

**Cast off.**

Join side seam and across the bottom with mattress stitch.

**Using 4.50mm crochet hook chain 46.  
 Thread through the holes and tie.**
