

Facecloth

Materials:

Countrywide Soft Cotton x 1 ball
4.00mm needles & 4.00mm Crochet hook

Abbreviations

Sl1 – slip next stitch knit wise from left handle needle to right without working

Cast on 53 stitches

1 Row: Knit

2 Row: K1, *Sl1, K1* repeat from * to * to end of row

3 Row: Knit

4 Row: K2, *Sl1, K1* repeat until last 3 stitches then Sl1, K2

5 Row: Knit

Repeat rows 2-5 for 20cm or until length required end with a knit row.

We did 45 rows in total

Cast off. Sew in ends.

Soap Bag

Made for using Knit World soaps

Cast on 33 stitches

1 Row: Knit

2 Row: K1, *Sl1, K1* repeat from * to * to end of row

3 Row: Knit

4 Row: K2, *Sl1, K1* repeat until last 3 stitches then Sl1, K2

5 Row: Knit

Repeat rows 2-5 10 more times ending having finished row 5.

Holes for cord

K1, *YO, K2tog* repeat to end of row.

Knit

K1, *Sl1, K1* repeat from * to * to end of row

Knit

K2, *Sl1, K1* repeat until last 3 stitches then Sl1, K2

Knit

K1, *Sl1, K1* repeat from * to * to end of row

Knit

Cast off.

Cord

Using 4.00mm crochet hook chain 50. Thread chain through holes at top and you can either join the ends to make a loop for hanging the soap, to make it easier for holding or leave it as one length for tying into a knot and bow.

Join the side seam and across the bottom with a mattress stitch for a flat seam.



1 ball makes both Facecloth and Soap Bag
