

How to Make a Crochet Make-Up Remover Pad

What you need:

1 ball of Countrywide Soft Cotton
4.00mm crochet hook
Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations (UK)

st - stitch, ch - chain stitch, sl st - slip stitch, yo - yarn over, puff st yo - insert hook into stitch, pull yarn through, do the same 4 more times then pull your yarn through all 11 loops on the hook, close the puff with a chain

The pads are worked in the round.

Foundation ring: Ch4, then join with a sl st to the first stitch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch1, *1 puff st, ch1; repeat from * 7 times (8 times in all), join with a sl st to the top of the first puff st and move with a sl st into the gap between the first and second puff st. (8 puff st.)

Round 2: Ch1, 2 puff st into first ch-1 space, then 2 puff st into each ch-1 space all the way round. Note that you don't chain between the stitches like you did on the first round. Once you have 16 puff st, join with a sl st to the first puff st. (16 puff st.)

Sew in the ends and there, you have your finished cotton pad.

Make a few more and hide them in your pal's wash bag or keep for yourself in a dressing table jar
