



TEXTURED COWL WITH MATCHING SLOUCHY BEANIE INTERMEDIATE

ACCESSORIES

- A circular 5.00mm (UK6) and a set of 5.00mm (UK6) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- Wool needle

TENSION

20 sts and 24 rows to 10cm over main patt, using 4.00mm needles. To work a 12cm x 12cm tension square, using 5.00mm needles, cast on 26 sts. Work 28 rows main patt. Cast off loosely. Check your tension carefully. If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

MEASUREMENTS

Cowl - Width	100	cm
- Length	35	cm
Slouchy beanie - to fit head	56	cm

MATERIALS

FIDDLESTICKS CAKE 200g balls

Quantity	2	balls
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Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

COWL

Using 5.00mm circular needle, cast on 216 sts.

Beg Main Patt –

Round 1 – Purl.

Round 2 – * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rounds 1 and 2 incl form main patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 30cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt round.

Beg Band Patt –

Round 1 – Knit.

Round 2 – * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 round form band patt.

Cont in band patt until work measures 35cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt round.

Cast off loosely in knitways.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in all ends.

SLOUCHY BEANIE

Using a set of 5.00mm, cast on 100 sts.

Beg Band Patt –

Round 1 – Knit.

Round 2 – * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 round form band patt.

Cont in band patt until work measures 5cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt round.

Beg Main Patt –

Round 1 – Purl.

Round 2 – * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rounds 1 and 2 incl form main patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx. 20cm from beg, ending with a 2nd patt round.

Shape Crown –

1st round – * P2tog, P8, rep from * to end ... 90 sts.

Work 3 rounds patt.

5th round - * P2tog, P7, rep from * to end ... 80 sts.

Work 1 round patt.

7th round - * P2tog, P6, rep from * to end ... 70 sts.

Work 1 round patt.

9th round - * P2tog, P5, rep from * to end ... 60 sts.

Work 1 round patt.

11th round - * P2tog, P4, rep from * to end ... 50 sts.

Work 1 round patt.

13th round - * P2tog, P3, rep from * to end ... 40 sts.

Work 1 round patt.

15th round - * P2tog, P2, rep from * to end ... 30 sts.

16th round - * Patt2tog, patt1, rep from * to end ... 20 sts.

17th round - * P2tog, rep from * to end ... 10 sts.

Thread yarn through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.

Pompon - Make a 8cm pompon and sew to top of beanie as pictured.

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
