## Wellington Hospital Baby Beanie Knitting Pattern

<b>Sizes</b>	1.4kg-1.8kg	1.8kg-2.5kg
<b>Length</b>	15cm	17cm
<b>Cast on</b>	90sts	90sts

**Materials**  
1 x 25g ball 3 or 4 ply 100% Wool  
1 pair 3.25 needles

### Basic Pattern

Cast on required number of stitches as above. Work in double rib to length required as above.

Decreasing row \*K2 tog, P2 tog, repeat from

\* to end. Work 6 rows in single rib.

Break off yarn long enough to thread onto a needle and pull through stitches. Sew up with a flat seam.

Make pom pom if desired.
