


# Help Keep New Zealand Children living in poverty warm during Winter by Knitting a Scarf or a Pair of Slippers

## Slippers

### Materials:

12ply, 2 x 50g (64m), 4.50mm needles DK 2 strands together, Small, Medium 2 x 50g (95m), Large 3 x 50g (95m), 5.50mm needles

Sewing up needle and 2 stitch markers

Abbreviations – ssk: slip the first stitch as if to knit, slip the second stitch as if to knit, then slide the left-hand needle into the front part of both stitches and knit them together

m1: make 1 stitch

3 sizes – Small, Medium and Large

### Sole

Cast on 50sts, 56sts, 62sts

Row 1: k25 (28, 31)sts Place marker k25(28, 31)sts

Row 2: \* k1, m1, k23 (26, 29) m1, K1 \* twice. (54, 60, 66sts)

Row 3: and all odd rows knit

Row 4: \* k1, m1, k25 (28, 31) m1, k1 \* twice. (58, 64, 70sts)

Row 6: \* k1, m1, k27 (30, 33) m1, k1 \* twice. (62, 68, 74sts)

Row 8: \* k1, m1, k29 (32, 35) m1, k1 \* twice. (66, 72, 78sts)

Row 10: \* k1, m1, k31 (34, 37) m1, k1 \* twice. (70, 76, 82sts)

Next row K34 (37, 40)sts K2tog K34 (37, 40)sts

Garter st (every row knit) 3 rows

### Instep

Row 1: p30 (33, 36) Place marker, p9, Place Marker p30 (33, 36)

Row 2: k 23 (26, 29), ssk twice, k3tog, k9, sl1, k2tog, pss0, k2tog twice k23 (26, 29)

Row 3: purl

Row 4: k19 (22, 25) ssk twice k3tog, k9, sl1, k2tog, pss0, k2tog twice k19 (22, 25)

Row 5: purl

Row 6: k31 (34, 37) ssk turn

Row 7: sl1, p9 p2tog turn

Row 8: sl1, k9 ssk turn

Row 9: sl1, p9, p2tog turn

Repeat rows 8 & 9 until 37(39, 41) sts remain

Next row: sl1, K9 ssk (do not turn) knit to end. (36, 38, 40st)

Next row: purl 1 row

Rib 1 x 1 for 6 rows

Cast off loosely in rib

Finish using flat seam join sole and back seam

## Scarves (Length Guideline 115-140cm)

### Materials:

2 balls of DK/8ply 50g

5.00mm needles

Cast on 23 stitches

Knit in garter stitch until the 2 balls are used up, leaving enough yarn to cast off in garter stitch



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
